

Bahrain's installed power storage capacity



Overview

The total electricity installed capacity of Bahrain in end-2024 amounted to 5.3 gigawatts (GW), the sector is primarily driven by natural gas, which fuels six of the eight operational power plants. The only source to record annual growth was Solar energy, which increased by 0.70.
