

Cuba's new outdoor power supply



Overview

Since 2025, a major project has been underway to build 100 solar parks across the island with a total installed capacity of 2,000 megawatts, half of which have already begun operations. In Cuba's second-largest city, Santiago de Cuba, outdoor energy storage systems are transforming how businesses and communities access reliable power.
