

Do lead-acid batteries need to be recharged and how long



Overview

Apply a saturated charge to prevent sulfation taking place. With this type of battery, you can keep the battery on charge as long as you have the correct float voltage. For larger batteries, a full charge can take up to 48 hours. Sealed lead-acid batteries can ensure high peak currents but you should avoid full discharges all the way to zero. The best recommendation is to charge after every use to ensure that. As with all batteries, take care of and handle your batteries appropriately and if you are unsure or have further questions, consult the manual provided. To prolong the lifespan of a battery, if you need to put your battery into storage, keep it above 2.05V and apply a topping charge every six months to keep the battery in tip-top shape. This will help to prevent any unnecessary damage. Although perfectly safe when used correctly, sealed lead-acid batteries are rated as toxic and need to be disposed of correctly. This type of battery is not one that you can dispose of in a regular trash can.

How Does Lead-Acid Batteries Work?

Lead-acid batteries are prone to a phenomenon called sulfation, which occurs when the lead plates in the battery react with the sulfuric acid electrolyte to form lead sulfate (PbSO_4). Over time, these lead sulfate crystals can build up on the plates, reducing the battery's capacity and eventually rendering it unusable.

Fill the battery with distilled or de-ionized water to cover the plates if low. Never add electrolyte. Fill water level to designated level after charging. Overfilling when ...
