

Ethiopia solar incentives



Overview

In a high-profile signing ceremony at the Ministry of Water and Energy headquarters in Addis Ababa, officials unveiled a suite of ambitious projects aimed at accelerating solar deployment, boosting rural electrification, and reinforcing Ethiopia's leadership in renewable energy and green industry development. Technical discussions emphasized the importance of strengthening the grid, preparing for renewable energy auctions, and scaling up investments. This Compact serves as both a strategic blueprint and a call to action, mobilizing national leadership, local communities, development partners, and the private sector in a collective effort to transform Ethiopia's energy. The National Roadmap for Scaling Up Productive Use of Renewable Energy (PURE) in Ethiopia was developed by the Ethiopian Solar Development Association (ESEDA) and the National PURE Taskforce chaired by the Ministry of Water and Energy (MoWE), with the financial support of the German Federal Government. Ethiopia has taken a bold leap towards its clean energy future, sealing a landmark partnership with the International Solar Alliance (ISA) and global renewable energy innovators. The country has succeeded in mobilizing approximately \$400 million in terms of grants from multilateral vertical funds including Global Environment Facility (GEF), Green Climate Fund (GCF) and Adaptation Fund (AF) in the last decade. The Grand Ethiopian Renaissance Dam (GERD) is a landmark project that will significantly increase Ethiopia's renewable energy capacity. The Ethiopian Solar Energy Development Association has called on the government to implement incentives to promote wider adoption of solar power technology, particularly to support agricultural development.
