

Hanoi electricity generation



Overview

Hanoi's electricity system has remained stable despite record-breaking demand driven by an intense heatwave in late May 2026. The city's power utility postponed planned outages while national grid operators increased generation capacity to manage surging consumption. Deputy Minister of Industry and Trade Nguyen Hoang Long has signed Decision No. Without a sustainable recovery process, waste resources are not. On June 10, in Can Tho City, Power Generation Corporation 2 – Joint Stock Company (EVNGENCO2) successfully held its 2026 Annual General Meeting of. Successive heatwaves have shattered electricity consumption records in the capital, yet EVNHANOI has not only avoided rolling blackouts but has also proactively postponed all scheduled power outage. Hanoi City People's Committee has issued Plan No. 353/KH-UBND dated 3/12/2024 on Hanoi City Power Development Plan 2025 to ensure a safe, stable, and uninterrupted power supply to serve the socio-economic development of the capital and meet the electricity needs of the people.
