Eurosolar Lëtzebuerg asbl has announced the inauguration of the first AgriPV installation in Kehlen on 18 October 2024, an installation undertaken by GPSS S. The installation has a capacity of 1. 999 MWp with a total of 3,570 photovoltaic modules on an area of 4. No concrete is used. As part of the 2030 Integrated National Energy and Climate Plan (PNEC), the Ministry of the Economy is supporting the development of agri-PV in Luxembourg through calls for tenders. An initial call was launched in 2023, followed by a second in 2025, which is open from 15 February to 1 September. The call for tenders relates exclusively to the installation of so-called agrivoltaic power stations. The Solarcontainer represents a grid-independent solution as a mobile solar plant. Especially in remote areas it can guarantee a stable energy supply or support or almost replace a public grid with strong power fluctuations, as well. Indeed, Luxembourg must aim to cover 100% of its final energy consumption from renewable sources.
