Overview

Montenegro already satisfies 45.5% of its energy needs through renewable energy sources, and has set an ambitious target of 50% by 2030. To achieve this target, accelerating the development of wind and solar energy is essential. Montenegro is taking an important step in advancing its green transition with the launch of the country's Renewable Energy Sources (RES Montenegro) Association, a new platform bringing together existing and potential investors in the renewable energy sector. Expanding wind and solar energy at this scale means making choices. The Montenegro country profile provides a concise overview of key trends across three dimensions: environment and climate; socio-economic change; and system change (energy, mobility and food) in the country. It highlights the main developments and challenges in these areas, including measures to.
