

Rome electric vehicle infrastructure



Overview

Rome is set to roll out 250 electric buses and 100% renewable-powered charging, bringing zero-emission transport to the city's east and west districts. This initiative is part of one of Europe's most ambitious urban bus electrification projects, led. The charging time will benefit from a greater spread of DC and High Power Charging infrastructure (also thanks to PNRR funds) and from the increase in the maximum «acceptable» power from the internal charging system of EVs. The project represents a major shift towards sustainable mobility, with a fleet. Italy's Recovery and Resilience Plan provides this investment, which consists in the procurement of at least 3 000 zero-emission low-floor buses and at least 1 000 charging stations for zero-and low-emission low-floor buses.
