Overview

Solar photovoltaic power plants have started emerging in some parts of the Kosovo Energy Corporation (KEK). It will contribute to significantly reducing greenhouse gas emissions and pave the way for further investment. The “Solar 4 Kosovo II” project is one of the largest energy projects in Kosovo. It will be one of the largest solar plants in Europe and the first in the region in terms of capacity, using clean solar energy for the benefit of heating.
